Highlights from The Parish Council Meeting:

- **Spiritual life of parish:** Weekly Gospel reading has about 10 people regularly attending. Possible parish mission discussed. Fr. gave a preview of the Diocesan four year plan for Evangelization. Upcoming holy hour on December 3rd (2-3p.m.) mentioned.
- **Faith Formation:** FFY program has 49 students enrolled...going well. Two high school students are attending the NCYC.
- **Building and grounds:** Bob shared a plan/bid for \$107,000.00 by Keith Steele Construction for renovation and enclosing car port in the front area of church. Discussion followed. Bob is to get a second bid. Have another council meeting before presenting to the parish at large.
- **Termite discussion followed:** Roy volunteered to research the area of damage and repair it after the holidays.
- **Insect Spraying in church:** It was approved to have quarterly spraying.
- **Carpet Cleaning:** Suggested that spots by the entrance of church be cleaned without getting a professional carper cleaner. Sanctuary carpet did not need cleaning. The burn spots on the carpet were discussed. Available spare carpet in garage for repair. Decided to wait and see how the renovation plans progressed and possibly do at the same time.
- **Angel Tree:** The angel tree will again be placed in the entrance of church. Money only gifts will be taken and given to children in parish as well as "Family First" in Smithland.

A voice of one crying out in the desert:
Mark 1:1-8

“One mightier than I is coming after me.” Mark 1:1-8

Christmas is the day we celebrate the birth of Jesus, the Incarnate Word of God. It is a very special moment for all Christians. It is a time of giving. Have you finished your Christmas shopping yet? Have you even finished making your Christmas list? What gift have you prepared for Jesus? Is Jesus even on your Christmas list? Should he not be at the top of our list? In the first lines of Mark’s Gospel we see that Jesus is at the top of John’s list. He has prepared the way for Jesus. He recognized that “One mightier than I is coming after me.” John’s gift was his humble recognition of Jesus as the one who “will baptize you with water and the Holy Spirit.” If we have no other gift for Jesus, we can humbly acknowledge God as the source of all that we are and have and spend time pondering how we use all that God has given us to the best of our ability in the year to come. Jesus would love such a gift.
