

Northeast Missouri Agriculture Educators Lifetime Achievement Award

General Information

- Name of Award: Agriculture Educators Lifetime Achievement Award
- Awards Given: An individual plaque will be awarded to the recipient at the Missouri Livestock Symposium on the first evening of MLS at approximately 7 p.m. each year. In addition, the individual(s) name will be inscribed on a perpetual plaque that is on display at the Adair County Extension Center.
- Objective: To honor those agriculture educators who have made considerable contributions to agriculture in northeast Missouri through their educational efforts over the years.

Selection Process

A selection screening committee, appointed and approved by the Missouri Livestock Symposium Committee, will rate the top application(s). These will then be sent to the Agriculture Educators Lifetime Achievement Award Selection Committee, which will submit their recommendation(s) to the Missouri Livestock Symposium Committee for final selection and approval.

Eligible Applicants

- 1) Eligible applicants must have been residents (do not have to be current residents) of one of the following Northeast Missouri Counties: Adair, Clark, Knox, Lewis, Linn, Macon, Marion, Monroe, Pike, Putnam, Randolph, Ralls, Schuyler, Scotland, Shelby or Sullivan.
- 2) Only living applicants shall be considered.
- 3) Individual(s) receiving this award must have made significant contributions to the agriculture industry in northeast Missouri through educational efforts.
- 4) Those professions generally given considerations for this award are Vo-Ag Instructors, University Extension personnel, Youth Educators, College and University faculty, staff of agriculture or farm organizations, and agriculturally related financial professionals. Other parties not included in this list but deemed eligible based on the selection criteria shall also be considered and are encouraged to apply.

Application Deadline

All applications must be received no later than 5 p.m., August 1, each year.

Photo Requirements

Wallet size or larger color photo of applicant may be requested by the selection committee.

*Please note: All application materials become the property of the Missouri Livestock Symposium Committee and will not be returned unless formally requested at time of application.
