Who doesn't know Jim Henson and his wonderful creations, The Muppets! Well, back in the 80s, us Silly Creatures got a new show from the Jim Henson Company for HBO called Fraggle Rock.

This show has had a special place in my heart, ever since I was a kid. Thus, with me being a Silly Creature, I decided to do a special cover for the show, because the Fraggles deserve it. So, here is how I, a Silly Creature from Outer Space, did that.


I searched the internet for pictures of the five main Fraggle characters and the Fraggle Rock logo. After making my selections, I put the Fraggle Rock logo in the middle of the page, followed by the Red Fraggle bent over in front of the logo. Red's pony tail barely touches the R and it goes to the bottom of the O. Her left hand is touching the K, with her tail being just under it. Next, I placed Boober Fraggle in the upper right hand corner, looking as miserable as ever. Boober's got one hand behind his back, with the other hand holding his scarf. Here, Boober is declaring "Don't do that! It'll bring death and pestilence!"

After that, I inserted my favorite character, Fraggle Wembley, in the upper left hand corner in a sort of "TA-DA" pose. In the lower right hand corner of this cachet, I placed Gobo Fraggle, with his arms straight out to his sides. The last character was Mokey Fraggle, and I put her in the lower left hand corner with her one hand in the air and the other on her chest.

To complete my work, I typed "32nd Anniversary Of" between Wembley and Boober at the top of this cachet.

After my Fraggle Rock cachet was completed, I printed it on my envelopes, put stamps on them, and then addressed them all to myself. After mailing my Fraggle Rock covers on the 24th of January, I received all of them back by January 28.
