Excerpts from Christopher Rufo's March 2021 Lecture at Hillsdale College

Today's *Critical Race Theory* holds basically the same beliefs as those found in 20th Century Marxism. Marxists believed that in industrial societies there would always be a struggle between the capitalists and the workers and the only solution to this imbalance of power was revolution.

Anywhere Communist revolutions have succeeded, the results have been disastrous. In the Soviet Union, China and Cuba over 100 million people were killed by the Communists through executions, mass starvation and simply murder. It turns out these examples aren't a very good selling point for recruiting new followers to Marxist Communist ideals.

Throughout the 1960's the centerpiece of reform in America was civil rights. As the 20th Century advanced, Americans saw things were getting better. The middle class was growing, people were moving up the ladder of opportunity and Americans preferred the idea of improving their country to that of overthrowing it.

So, how could the Marxists bring in new followers? They did what all successful species in nature do...they adapted. Instead of talking about freeing the *workers* they changed to freeing the *victims of systemic racism*. They talk of "equity" instead of "equality." Since the two words sound alike and sound non-threatening, people think *equity* must be a good idea since the principle of equality is good and is mentioned in the Declaration of Independence.

To Critical Race theorists, however, "equality" is just camouflage for white supremacy, patriarchy and oppression. What the country really needs is equity, social justice, diversity and inclusion.

UCLA and Boston University professors wrote recently that private property rights should be suspended. Wealth and land should be seized and redistributed along racial lines. A Federal Department of "Antiracism" should be created. This department would be unaccountable to any of the elected branches of government and could abolish any law in the land and curtail the speech of any political leader that they thought was not "antiracist" enough.

Critical Race Theory in practice is involved with training workers in all government agencies, school faculties, military departments and even in the curriculum of elementary school children. The message is always the same. If you are white, male, an owner of property or a business, you are guilty of racism and privilege and must proclaim your guilt to the world. You must apologize and prostrate yourself in front of others. Everyone must be converted to the ideology of "antiracism."

Thus far any attempts to stop critical race theory have not worked very well. Many Americans have a fear of speaking up about social and political issues, especially if race is mentioned. A recent Gallup poll found that 77% of conservatives are afraid to share their political beliefs publicly. Afraid of being mobbed on social media, fired from their jobs or worse they remain quiet.

Critical race theory has become a tool of political power. HOWEVER...If we want to oppose it we must address it politically at every level. The Critical Racists must be forced to speak to the facts. Several state legislatures have introduced bills to prevent public institutions from stereotyping, scapegoating or demeaning people on the basis of race. If we stand together, truth and justice are on our side. If we are courageous we will win. Read more at...

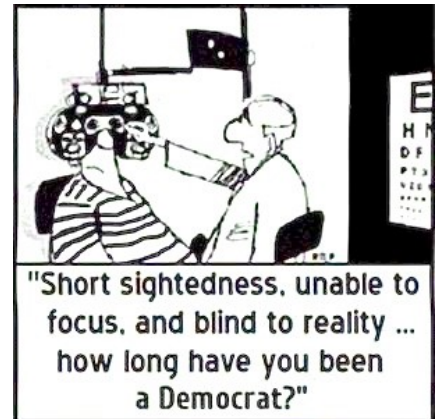
