Zingers & Flingers Inc. Range Rules

Range safety rules are non-negotiable. Failure to comply with the following established rules will result in loss of range privileges, up to and including forfeiture of paid range time. We reserve the right to deny services to anyone for any reason. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times while on the range.

All shooters under 18 years of age must have parental approval and be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times while on the range. No persons under the age of 7 years old will be permitted on the range for any reason at any time.

Children must not be left unattended, and a 1:1 child to adult ratio must be maintained at all times.

No pregnant women are allowed on the range, for health reasons.

Be sure that your firearm is safe to operate and know how to operate it safely. Always keep your firearm unloaded, your finger off of the trigger and the muzzle pointed in a safe direction until ready to shoot. Never hand a loaded firearm to another person. If sharing a lane, firearms must be placed on the shooting bench, never handed from person to person. Failure to comply will not be tolerated.

Use only the correct ammunition for your firearm. If you have any questions, please consult a Range Officer. Steel, unjacketed, armor piercing, tracer and military surplus ammunition are prohibited. Ammunition will be inspected and tested by the Range Officers. Repeated violation of this rule will result in permanent barring from the range.

Food and beverages are prohibited on the ranges. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on the property. Individuals displaying the effects of, or thought to be under the influence of, drugs or alcohol will be prohibited from using any of the ranges.

Range officers are authorized to remove any shooter whose behavior is detrimental to the safe operations of any of the ranges. Commands issued by any Range Officer must be followed immediately.

If unsafe behavior is noticed, then please make sure that the Range Officer is notified of such action immediately.

Please read and understand the Range Rules and Regulations before you proceed to any of the ranges. Please ask any of the Range Officers for clarification if you have any questions.

Maximum of two people are allowed per shooting position, at the same time.

Uncased firearms must be kept in the preparation room, at all times. Case and uncase them in the preparation rooms only. One firearm per lane at any given time. If using multiple firearms during allotted range time, additional firearms must be kept in locker until ready to use.

Only load your firearm when you are on the firing line, keeping the muzzle pointed downrange at all times. Keep actions open when not shooting.

No handgun drawing from a holster is allowed, without the prior approval of the Range Officer. If you have a malfunction or a jam that you cannot clear, lay the firearm on the bench while keeping the muzzle pointed downrange, and ask the Range Officer for assistance. Never remove a jammed or malfunctioning firearm from the range without prior approval from the Range Officer. When you finish shooting, unload your firearm before leaving the preparation room. Your brass may be picked up if you would like to keep it; otherwise, it can be left on the floor. Never extend past the firing line to pick up brass. Please place your trash in the receptacle.

Never extend any part of your body forward of the firing line for any reason. Consult the Range Officer for retrieval of items dropped beyondthe firing line.And please, always obey the 4 laws of firearm safety:

1 - The Gun Is Always Loaded!

2 - Never Point The Gun At Something You Are Not Prepared To Destroy

3 - Always Be Sure Of Your Target And What Is Behind It!

4 - Keep Your Finger Off The Trigger Until Your Sights Are On The Target!

RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

Revised 12/23/16

In consideration of participating in the gun club, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence Zingers & Flingers Inc. and its owners, directors, officers employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

(1.) I acknowledge that the gun club activities involve known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to, death or serious injury as a result of being shot or as a result of equipment malfunction; hearing loss; loss of vision; broken bones, bruises and other bodily injuries caused by falls; medical conditions resulting from physical activity, and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

(2.) I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.

3.) I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

(4.) I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

(5.) In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so solely in the state where Releasees' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.

(6.) I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect. By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release, and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.

I have never been convicted of and I currently am not under indictment of a felony in any court.

I am not prohibited by law from possessing a firearm under Wisconsin State Statue 941.29

I will not use unjacketed, steel core, armor piercing, tracer or military surplus ammunition on the range.
