

# BB Range Commands



**ON THE FIRING LINE** Shooters takes their assigned place at the firing line and prepare to fire, but do not load their guns

**IS THE LINE READY?** (If OK, NO TALKING, Any shooter not ready, will raise their hand and call out **NOT READY**, and give their Target Number)

Range Master calls out **THE LINE IS NOT READY**

The Range Master will investigate the problem and assist in correcting it

**IS THE LINE READY?** (If You are Ready, NO TALKING)

**THE LINE IS READY**

**LOAD** Shooters load their BB guns

**READY ON THE FIRING LINE**

**COMMENCE FIRING** (shooters begin to fire their gun)

After each shooter is finished, they OPEN the Bolt, OPEN the Pumping Lever, lay the UNLOADED GUN on the Mat, then they sit at the BACK of the Mat BEHIND their gun.

After ALL shooters finish, **CEASE FIRING — CLEAR ALL GUNS**

All BB guns are unloaded, laid down and ALL shooters move back from the Firing Line

**CEASE FIRING** means there is a problem on the Range, and ALL shooters need to STOP SHOOTING and lay down their gun

**AS YOU WERE / CARRY ON** means to continue what you were doing before the interruption occurred.

- STOP • DON'T TOUCH • LEAVE THE AREA • TELL AN ADULT
