Approximately how many producers, consumers or registrants were involved?

Between both programs (NE and SD) we reached 43 producers in-person (21 in NE and 22 in SD). The program was also offered virtually and attended by 7.

What happened at this event?

With the growing interest of starting sheep enterprises, extension professionals and state sheep association executives from South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas developed a program for producers with existing operations that are interested in starting a sheep enterprise. The program was delivered in O'Neill, NE on June 8th, and Chamberlain, SD on June 9th. The program included topics on multi-species grazing, general sheep production, and how to economically incorporate sheep into an operation. The workshop began with a presentation from Dr. Alison Crane, Wyoming Wool Grower Association Executive Secretary on the benefits of multi-species grazing. We had great discussion about rotation options between cattle and sheep, fencing, and livestock guardian animals. Next, Jaelyn Quintana, SDSU Extension Sheep Field Specialist opened up discussion on general considerations when starting a sheep enterprise covering a wide variety of topics from diseases to vaccination protocols to market trends. Randy Saner Extension Educator for UNL discussed nutritional differences when developing rations for sheep and cattle. Dr. Lisa Surber presented on marketing options for both lambs and wool. The day ended with a panel discussion with three experienced producers that have also offered to serve as mentors.


