

Landscape Report

December 2017

- Viburnum replacement on the hedges at Perc Pond 2 was completed.
- Soil samples were taken and tested at 10 points around the property. Salinity okay, pH is alkaline.
- Estimates were received for replacement of shrubs at the WWTP and Rec Center. After discussion about plant survival and irrigation needs we agreed to move forward with the replacement of the hedge plants at the Rec Center and WWTP. Work will begin next week. Green Pittosporum will be used for the privacy hedge.
- The washout on the West Pond will be repaired next week and Bahia sod placed.
- ProScapes was brought in to look at the dead trees along the bike path and estimate the cost to take them down.
- The palm boots are scheduled to be cleaned up from the East pond and pine straw placed starting the first week in December.
- Pine straw to be placed around WWTP, Rec Center and Beach Club where dead shrubs have been removed.
- Grasses will be replanted and pine straw placed at the rec center in front of the pool.
- Irrigation repairs at the break by the north west entrance are pending availability of S & G to do the work digging up the asphalt.
