To Enter:

RULE #1 – Have FUN!

\$5.00 entry fee includes your display easel and one canvas. – One canvas per easel per entry - A limited number of extra canvases will be available. **Every kit you purchase supports a student's entry!**

Use VVF kits only – artwork on un-approved supports will not be accepted.

Artists may submit as many pieces as they like as long as each is unique. Artists may submit a triptych or a group of artists may work on a theme and submit several items as a group.

Entries must be original work created by the submitting Artist.

ANY media can be used, paint, pencil, crayon, embroidery, twigs, fabric, rocks, wallpaper collage, rubber stamps, stencils, found objects, anything. (well, ALMOST anything, nothing stinky or sticky or that might rot ...) either side of canvas may be used and canvas may be displayed vertically or horizontally. Watercolor or other media not suitable for canvas may be applied to paper and attached to canvas.

Photographs may also be attached to the canvas.

Subject matter is entirely up to the artist as there is no 'theme' for 12squared. Please keep in mind that this is a family event and objectionable content (profanity, nudity, etc.) will be rejected by the jury.

Finished canvas must sit securely on the easel, you may attach the canvas to the easel but it must stand on its own. Easel must stand upright on the flat bottom of the back leg***.

You <u>may not alter the easel</u> (paint it, decorate it, but no alterations to the structure will be accepted.)

Each piece must be <u>legibly</u> marked on the back with the artists name, telephone number and email address (if available). Information must be securely attached or written directly on the back of the artwork. This is in addition to the display card. (hint: scotch tape will not secure)

Complete the information on the enclosed card and submit with your artwork (you may decorate the card as well...see instructions on back of card)

This will be a juried show. Winners in Divisions #1 & 2 will receive monetary awards based upon the number of paid entries received. All divisions will receive Non-monetary awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place as well as a People's Choice award.

Divisions:

- 1- Adult Experienced/Professional
- 2 Adult Novice
- 3 Student1 Grades 11 & 12
- 4 Student 2- Grades 9 & 10

Entries will be judged on the following:

All - Composition, Content, Originality, Visual Impact

In addition:

Class: B – Line and Form

Class C – Creative use of materials

Classes:

A -Traditional (landscapes, portrait, still life, abstract acrylic, watercolor, oil, ink, pastel etc.)

B - Drawings - any media

C - Mixed Media – collage, assemblage, shadow box, anything else.

All artwork will be offered for sale during Fall Festival. If you wish to "buy back" your piece, you may do so for \$5. Base sale price for all entries will be \$5. Any amount over \$5 will be split 50/50 with the artist. Unsold artworks will be held until the 1218 Verde Valley Fair and offered for sale at that time. Items which are not juried into the exhibit or sold during the Fair will be returned to the artist (contact Fair Office for details).

*** you may create a small weighted stop to keep the back leg of the easel from sliding.
