

## **DECEMBER '23 CHARITY REPORT:**

As always, December is **Toys for Tots** month! After last year's *WET* show day, we were hoping for a mild, *SUNNY* day so we could collect a record amount of toys and cash. You know how it went *AGAIN* this year . . . *BUT* we did pretty well!

We collected a grand total of 321 toys (*approx* value \$18 ea), 2 bikes (value \$100 ea) and \$3,000 in cash! A figure we can be proud of, given the conditions Maw Nature gave us!

How did we do it? We started collections at Handy Ace Hardware and Treasures on the Railroad a couple weeks prior to the show. By show day we had several FULL boxes, then on our actual show day, we had guite a few come donate, even if they didn't enter the show. Our Auction got all but canceled once again, but we still played "Let's Make A Deal" and sold a few items. The Marines sold a good amount of 50/50 tickets, and winner Don Brock donated his winning back to Toys for Tots. All this totalled almost \$1,500, with which we were pleased. BUT WAIT! Club member and Sponsor Leigh Fragnoli "sweetened" the pot with another \$1,500 and the Club added enough to round it up to a "Cool" THREE GRAND!

We are pretty sure that Handy Ace raided their seasonal toy aisle to help fill some of the boxes.
