December's competition will be the Toy Soldier Fun Shoot. These competitions are at 1:00 PM on the first Saturday of the month.

License to Carry (LTC) Practice: These are held every other Thursday night from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The next dates for the evening LTC practice are November 17th and December 1st. Daytime LTC practice on Tuesday 22nd at 9:00 AM. The participants get the opportunity to practice drawing from their concealment with their everyday carry pistols. All participants are closely monitored to provide a safe and fun atmosphere. There are multiple scenarios and barricades to practice various aspects of defending oneself if the situation ever presents itself.

Action Pistol: Practices and holds their events every other Wednesday starting at 6:00 PM. The next one will be on Wednesday the December 6th. 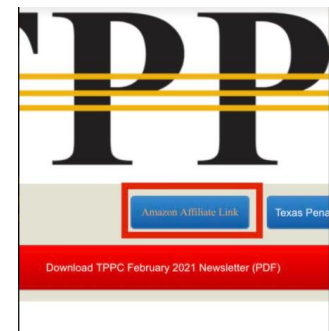

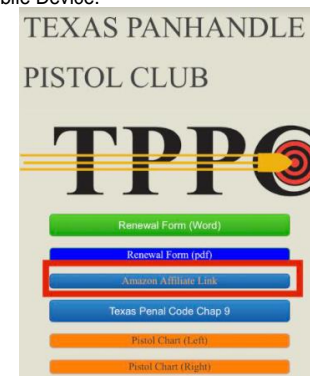

November's Shooting Drill – 10 Shot Drill

Using the free targets at the range (Bore Rifle Target). The one with 12 bullseyes on it. Take a pen label the top left as 1, the next to the right as 2, the last one on the top row as 3. Second row label them as 4, 5. This is all we will use for now, we'll end up using only 5 of the targets.

Put 2 rounds in your magazine, load, and start at low ready. At 3 yards shoot the '1' target 2 times as quickly as you can. Repeat 4 more times. Each time attempt to get on target and get both shoots in below 2 seconds. If you miss the target on any of the 2 shoots, you failed that round.

Shooting for this drill is for accuracy and speed. This will help you with speed on target and controlled shooting pairs. Concentrating on grip, sight, and squeezing the trigger.

Work accomplished this month was: Check range lighting, check lanes for functioning, clean up around building and put in dumpster, sweep (Use floor sweep), vacuum firing line and pew, clean table, and check phone messages, change Furnace Filter, clean Admin Building, drill holes in target backers, and spray weeds.

U.S.A. —(AmmoLand.com)- Emboldened by Tuesday's failure by Republicans to deliver a "red wave" at the polls, Joe Biden appeared at a press conference during which he allowed questions from a list of reporters he was provided, and at one point declared he will continue pushing to ban so-called "assault weapons."

According to the White House transcription and a report in Business Insider, the sometimes-cocky Biden reminded reporters about some of his "achievements" so far, including the gun control legislation he signed in June.

Biden gave a strong hint he will build on the gun control package from June.

"So, I'm not going to change — as a matter of fact, you know there's some things I want to change and add to. For example, we had — passed the most bipartisan, we passed the most extensive gun legislation, anti- — you know, rational gun policy in 30 years."

[Gun Sales Break 1 Million Mark for 38 Months in a Row](#)

U.S.A. —(Guns.com) — On November 7, 2022 (click on link above to read the entire article) Regardless of the outcome of the 2022 mid-term elections, Americans keep voting with their wallets when it comes to gun sales.

According to data based on federal background checks for likely over-the-counter gun sales, October 2022 was the 38th consecutive month in which such checks soared past the 1 million mark, putting the year on track to a near-record close.

The 38-month streak was announced by the National Shooting Sports Foundation after they sifted through the figures for the Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal Background Check System for last month. The unadjusted October 2022 FBI NICS figure of 2,475,869, after the data is sifted by NSSF to remove checks and rechecks for carry permits, remains at 1,427,264. All-told, last month's figures represent a more than three-year period starting in July 2019 where checks broke the million-per-month benchmark.
