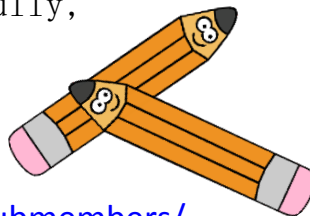
We have a few board positions that are vacant - if you would like to serve on our board do not hesitate to reach out. We are a fun group that loves to have fun while doing business.

The Scavenger Hunt will start promptly at 6pm on September 20, 2018. RSVP NLT September 17.

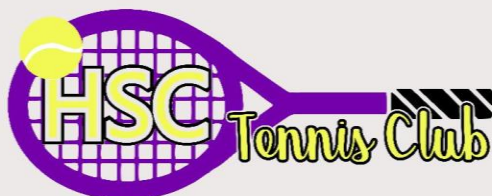
