790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

Florida law provides that an out-of-state resident must have in his or her immediate possession a valid license to **carry a concealed** weapon or **firearm**. ... **HOWEVER**, any licensee of these **reciprocity** states who is not 21 years of age or older is prohibited from **carrying a concealed** weapon or **firearm** in **Florida**.
