The same slate of classes will be run in the same order as we had in 2018 for each 2019 event. Entry fees are expected to stay the same except slightly higher at the Grasslands Market Slide due to the added money. Be sure to get these dates outlined on your calendars and plan on joining the fun and friendship at the 2019 CSRHA events! We love to see everyone and their horses improve at each of the CSRHA events.

Once again, keep in mind that the CSRHA election period for two board of director positions officially opened on **November 1** and will continue through **December 15**.
