

# **INA McMULLEN**

## **1909 - 1993**

Ina Mae McMullen, age 83 of Sand Point, formerly of Collax Township, passed away Sunday, May 9 at the Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe, following a long illness.

She was born July 31, 1909 in Collax Township, daughter of the late William and Laura (DesJardin) Rapson. She married Secord McMullen on Sept. 6, 1928 at the Bad Axe United Methodist parsonage. He preceded her in death on Aug. 25, 1992. They had been married 64 years.

The couple farmed in Collax for many years, retiring to the Sand Point area. They were winter residents of Port Charlotte, FL.

Mrs. McMullen was a 1928 graduate of Bad Axe High School. She worked as a nurse at Hubbard Hospital and Huron Memorial Hospital. She was a member of Collax United Methodist Church, Eldon Senior Citizens and the Huron County Farm Bureau.

Surviving her are two grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; two foster sons, Ralph Wellman of Flint and Lloyd Wellman of Lansing; two foster grandchildren; one foster great-granddaughter and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by a daughter, Mrs. Stanley (Elaine) Shetler and two sisters, Mabel Murdock and Grace Roberts.
