Congratulations to our new Post officers: Commander Victor DE LA RO-SA, Finance Office Susan WOOD, First Vice Commander Jose MAR-TINEZ, Second Vice Commander John SCHUTZ, Third Vice Commander Gerardo ROBLEDO, and Executive Committee persons: David KULCIN-SKI and Sid GAUNA (two Exec. Comm. positions remain unfilled). Cmdr. DE LA ROSA has asked me to serve as Post Judge Advocate (appointive office) as well as Immediate Past Commander and I have agreed to do so.

That resulted in the resolution of many urgent and necessary matters long delayed like: parking lot repavement, 5 air conditioner replacements, bar and clubroom remodeling, gas lines repair, kitchen safety certifications, rental and staff contract upgrading, issuance of formal of operating rules and procedures, licensure up gradings, and so many other matters.


