Pre-Entry: \$15 per class + \$15 arena use fee per horse (\$5 per class non-EECO/HLPC member fee) Post Entry: \$20 per class + \$20 arena use fee per horse (\$5 per class non-EECO/HLPC member fee)

Jackpot Payback Scale:

3-5 riders pays 2 places 70%/30% 6-10 riders pays 3 places 50%/30%/20%

11-up riders pays 4 places 40%/30%/20%/10%
