Ages 6 to 11 Club Academy Soccer

Academy Soccer for Ages 6 to 11. Academy Soccer is designed to teach as well as develop soccer players to a higher level of ability. The players receive training from both professional as well as certified volunteer coaches. The academy program is designed to develop the player from a recreational player to a more advanced skill set player. Teams are formed based on players ability and commitment. An evaluation process is implemented to form A, B, and C level teams. These teams are then scheduled to play against teams with similar levels of ability from around Georgia. The focus of the program then becomes more important for development of the individual player and improvement of the team's ability to play the beautiful game. The emphasis during the academy games is not to win every game but to learn and develop the players. Tournaments are played to increase competition and develop team competition.

Ages 6 to 7 (U8) and (U9) Pre Academy Boys and Girls, \$250 for Fall or Spring or \$500 for the year Soccer Academy and Pre-academy (One night per week with a trainer, one night with Coach and at least 8 games)

Ages 8 and 9 (U10) Academy Boys and Girls, \$685 per year, or \$100 a month for 7 months \$700. Includes uniform, practice on 2 nights per week with Professional trainer or Certified Volunteer. August through October and February through May. At least 8 games in the Fall and 8 in the Spring, play other clubs in Atlanta area or Macon. Uniforms: 2 sets including one home jersey, one away jersey, one pair of shorts, two pair of socks and one practice tee. Extra practices and skills session schedules throughout the Fall and Spring Season.

Ages 10 or 11 (U12) Academy Boys and Girls, \$685 per year. Includes uniform, practice on 2 nights per week with Professional trainer or Certified Volunteer. August through October and February through May. At least 8 games in the Fall and 8 in the Spring, play other clubs in Atlanta area or Macon. Uniforms: 2 sets including one home jersey, one away jersey, one pair of shorts, two pair of socks and one practice tee. Extra practices and skills session schedules throughout the Fall and Spring Season.

Ages 12 to 18 Club Select Soccer

Select teams U13 and U14 play at a higher level against other select teams throughout GA. The Cost for the entire year is \$685. or \$100 a month for 7 months \$700 \$485 for the fall. Fee includes the following: Professional or Certified E level Training, practice on two nights per week August through October and February through May. At least 8 to 12 games in the Fall and Spring season, will play other clubs in Georgia based on Georgia Soccer Rules. The players receive training from both professional as well as certified volunteer coaches. **Select teams U15 and U19** play at a higher level against other select teams throughout GA. The Cost for the fall only year is \$485.. Fee includes the following: Professional or Certified E level Training, practice on two nights per week August through October. At least 8 to 12 games in the Fall, will play other clubs in Georgia based on Georgia Soccer Rules. The players receive training from both professional as well as certified volunteer coaches.

Recognizing the possibility of physical injury associated with soccer and in consideration for the USSF/USYSA, SUFC, GYSA, and its affiliates accepting the registrant for its soccer programs and activities (the "programs"), I hereby release, discharge, and/or otherwise indemnify the USSF/USYSA SUFC, GYSA, its affiliates, its affiliated organizations and sponsors, their employees and associated personnel, including the owners of fields and facilities utilized for the "programs" against any claim by or on behalf of the registrant as a result of the registrant's participation in the "programs" and/or being transported to or from the same, which transportation I hereby authorize. My son/daughter and or myself has received a physical examination by a physician and has been found physically capable of participating in the "programs". I hereby give consent to have an athletic trainer and/or doctor of medicine or dentistry provide my son/daughter with medical assistance and/or treatment and agree to be responsible financially for the reasonable cost of such assistance and/or treatment. I agree to assume all risks and hazards associated with the conduct of the program and all affiliations. I also agree to release USSF/USYSA, SUFC, GYSA, its affiliates, coaches and other league participants from any claims, demands, and injuries whether caused by negligent or intentional acts. I also agree to accept all field conditions as safe and playable.

I also agree to accept all rules and discipline actions. Once this form is complete, box is checked or the form is signed for the league, I agree to the SUFC Parent Code of Conduct and the Player Code of Conduct. I agree to pay the fee required to participate. I agree failure to pay the fee or attend any and all games practice does not warrant a refund or obligation to pay the debt. I also understand that all games and practices may not be played due to weather related cancellations or circumstances out of the control of the league. No refunds or discounts will be given if cancellations occur out of the control of the SUFC and its affiliates.

Player Code of Conduct.

1. Conduct and represent the club in a respectable manner. Be honest and reliable at all times.
2. Avoid the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol or any prohibitive substances (violation may result in suspension or dismissal from the club).
3. Portray an example of sportsmanship and fair play.
4. Always wear shin guards.
5. Always bring a properly inflated and appropriate-sized ball to all training and games.
6. Attend all training sessions and games unless excused by coach.
7. Notify coach in advance via phone and email of any expected tardiness or absence from any training session, practice, or game.
8. Avoid the use of profanity at all times. Strive to improve at each training session and always give 100% effort. Have both uniforms in training bag at all games.
9. Not question a referee's decision by word or gesture.
10. Always be respectful of opposing players, coaches, fans, and referees. Shake hands with opposing team and coaches after each game. Be supportive and positive towards their teammates. Commit to giving 100% effort during games.

Parent Code of Conduct

1. I agree to not hold any parental discussion with the coach until 24 hours after a session or game and away from the field or away from the presence of players and other parents (*cool down period*).
2. Not coach (*at all*) from sidelines during games or training. Only provide positive verbal support to players, coaches and referees (*when in doubt, silence is best*).
3. Never challenge referees call (s) either verbally or by way of gesture.
4. Defer to and support coach in handling any dispute, referee action, disciplinary action, or violation of this agreement or team rules.
5. Volunteer time to support the team and club (field maintenance, team administration, etc).
6. Always be respectful of opposing team, coaches, players and parents.
