

Parent Partnership – a program that is set up so that First Baptist School can come alongside parents and provide resources so as to better help our students succeed.

Problem: Recently students have been struggling in school, specifically with completing their homework, knowing how to study, and with basic comprehension skills. Much of this gap in what is happening and what should be happening, seems to be due to parents not fully understanding the importance they have on their child(ren)'s education; not understanding their children's assignments so not being able to help their child(ren) with their homework; not understanding their children's development process and overall needs at specific ages; not understanding how to create the conditions for their children to learn; not understanding the importance of health and nutrition on academic performance; not knowing about available programs regarding finances; and/or not fully understanding school processes and requirements.

Solution: An instructional plan has therefore been created that will help provide information and resources for parents to be able to create strong home environment and in turn help their children become successful students. With students having better home environments, their struggles with completing homework, in learning, with studying, and with comprehending will decrease; time at school for extended learning and extra activities will increase; and a strong partnership between First Baptist School and the parents will form.
