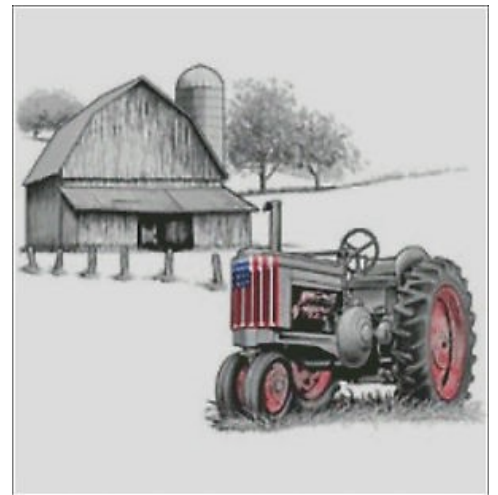

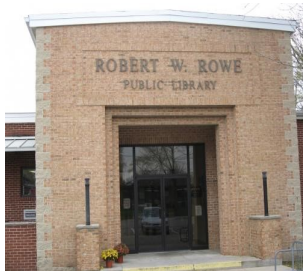
We are looking for volunteers to index items so if you have some extra time and would like to volunteer to index something, please let us know.

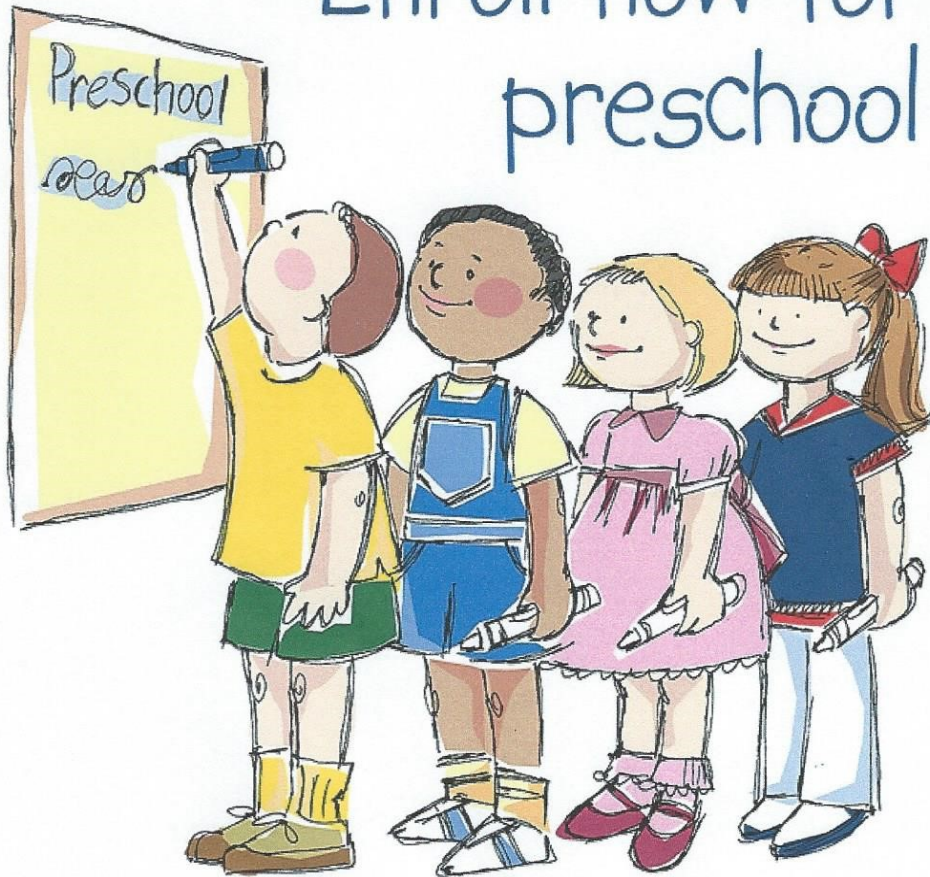
