ATTENDING MASSES IN O.M.P.H. IPOH

ONLY OMPH PARISHIONERS

(citizens & non-citizens) and those serving in OMPH ministries are allowed to attend weekday and weekend masses at OMPH church.

- * Must NOT have visited/been to COVID-19 RED ZONE areas within the past 14 days.
- * Do NOT have fever/flu symptoms.
- * Government SOPs of mask wearing, hand sanitizing and physical distancing of minimum 1 meter to be observed.
- * Checking in using MySejahtera App. is a requirement.
- ** Catholics residing in Kuala Lumpur and the state of Selangor are requested to refrain from travelling to neighbouring states to attend Mass to avoid risk of transmission.

Gospel: Matthew 2:1-12. "Beginnings, Endings & Revelations"

We have a unique opportunity to evaluate the end of another year of our pilgrimage in faith, to set our sights on the beginning of a new dimension of our call to discipleship and to reflect on what we have learned throughout this last year, living through pandemic, fear, and uncertainty.
