- Be approachable and available to discuss issues with players and parents/carers.
- Must have attended a child protection course and obtain an attendance certificate.
- Adhere to the rules of England Netball
- Will promote positive aspects of the sport
- Maintain high standards of behaviour and appearance
- Keep players, parents or carers informed of all relevant dates and decisions that affect the player/team.
- Have responsibility of team selection
- Endeavour to bring each individual to their full potential.
- Bring to the attention of the players, the drugs policy within England Netball
- Bring to the attention of the players information on health education
