Dale Swisher is currently the conductor of the Cincinnati Youth Symphony Concert Orchestra as well as the Xavier University Chamber Orchestra. His contributions to music education are numerous. In 2000 the Ohio Orchestra and String Teachers Association gave him the “Public School Teacher of the Year” award. His teaching positions have included: Forest Hills School District, Xavier University, Southeast Missouri State University, Eastern Kentucky University, Wooster College, Columbus Symphony Youth Orchestra, Cincinnati Youth Symphony Orchestra, All-Ohio State Fair Youth Symphony, Dayton All-City Orchestra and several OMEA District Honors Orchestras as well as honors groups in Kentucky, Tennessee and Missouri.

A graduate of Ohio State University and the University of Cincinnati, Mr. Swisher is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and the Cincinnati MacDowell Society. At C.C.M. he studied with Sigmund Efron, Concertmaster of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra.
