Patriot PAWS became a registered 501(c)(3) in 2006, and it's hard to believe how much they've grown since then! Their Main Campus in Rockwall, TX has grown from a tiny storefront to a 3-acre location which includes their administrative offices, a state-of-the-art veterinary clinic, 25-run kennel facility and a dedicated training facility. Their small staff is assisted by a host of volunteers from all walks of life doing everything from administrative work, providing veterinary care for the dogs, puppy raising, community outreach, hosting demonstrations and fundraisers on their behalf and much, much more. But with over 50 disabled American veterans waiting for a Patriot PAWS Service Dog there is still much work to be done and we need your help to help us help those who served.

Cathy has been a huge supporter of Patriot PAWS Service Dogs through a Benefit in Arizona that was established in 2015.

Benefit Party is currently in its 8th year and in this time has raised over \$88,000 for our disabled American veterans.
