Other Activities:

It is not too early to start planning for the many activities available to you on Oahu and Maui. Both the Outrigger Waikiki Beach Resort in Honolulu (www.outrigger.com/hotels-resorts/hawaii/oahu/outrigger-waikiki-beach-resort)

and the Honua Kai Resort on Maui (www.honuakai.com) are right on the beach, as shown above and to the right. Besides the pools, the beaches, fine restaurants, and shopping, there are many activities on the islands. Oahu offers Pearl Harbor, Diamond Head, Kailua Beach Park, the North Shore, and



Waimea Falls Park, among many other one-of-a kind locations. Visit the Haleakala Crater and National Park, the Wai'anapanapa State Park, and the Road to Hana tour on Maui. Naturally, at the resorts you'll also find daily and nightly entertainment, a fitness center, and a world class spa. Outside activities can also be arranged - including snorkeling, scuba diving, zip-lining, sport-fishing, golfing, biking, whale watching, and many other action adventures. There are also sunset dinner cruises and helicopter tours of the waterfalls, rain forests, and volcanic areas of the islands. You can reserve these adventures in advance by asking the travel agent or make the arrangements when you arrive at either resort.
