

DECEMBER 17, 2018 SUPERVISOR'S MEETING 2019 BUDGET FOR ADOPTION

The Polk Township Supervisors met for a Special Meeting to adopt the 2019 Budget on Monday, December 17, 2018 at 6:30pm at the Municipal Building, 165 Polk Twp. Rd., Kresgeville, PA. Supervisors Brian K. Ahner, and Carl S. Heckman were present. Supervisor Michael D. Hurley had a previous commitment. Also present were: Zoning/Codes Officer Justin Burkner & Treasurer Beverly A. Christman and Residents: Vincent Morello, Harold Touni Jr., and Robert Andre.

The proposed budget had been available for review since November 19, 2018 and no comments had been received from the public.

Public Comment: Touni asked if the Supervisor's had included funds for Christmas flags at the Township and Kresgeville village center which creates a community feeling. Ahner stated holiday flags were not displayed this season due to the bridge construction traffic which creates a dangerous environment for installing flags. Toner noted that flags must be bought yearly, since they are totally destroyed by the elements each season. A suggestion was made to display plastic holiday decorations since they will last longer than one season. Heckman agreed that the cost of plastic holiday decorations should be researched.

As there were no more comments, Ahner moved to approved the Budget for 2019 as presented; seconded by Heckman. Vote, 2-0. Motion carried.
