1. Laying of the Levy 2017-2018

Mayor Dettmer explained the Laying of the Levy 2017-2018 was a formality since the County sets the Levy rates but we have to approve the rates. *See attached copy for complete details.* **Councilperson Robert Hardy moved to approve the Levy rates as presented by Mayor Dettmer. Councilperson John Paul Heafer seconded the motion. Motion passed.**

2. Discuss and Possible Approval of Waste Management Collection

Mayor Dettmer asked the Council if they had considered paying \$135.00 for a Bagster so Bolivar residents could start their spring clean up and get rid of old/broken lawn furniture and other items that are making our town look unkept. Discussion followed about previous times we tried this to help out our residents. We also discussed how we would monitor this project, when we would get the Bagster and how to let Bolivar residents know when they could bring their items to discard. It was mentioned several times that no TV's or trash would be allowed. This project could help residents clean up their property before they receive a letter about keeping their property clean of debris. There would be no charge to Bolivar residents.


Councilperson Tim Collins moved to try the Bagster for Bolivar residents. Councilperson John Paul Heafer seconded the motion. Motion passed.
