

## MARLBOROUGH HIGH SCHOOL REQUIRED PERFORMANCE ATTIRE – 2018/2019

Marlborough High School and the MPS Music Association provide items in the column headed “issued”. Once performance attire and uniforms are assigned to the student, the items are the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian...

**All issued Performance Attire will be stored at school. Teachers will instruct students regarding this procedure.**

There are times Performance Attire will be taken out of school overnight. It is expected that the items be returned clean and in good repair the day following performance. If the items are not returned or cannot be used for performances, the student and parents/guardians will be responsible for providing funds to replace the item(s).

**Note: Black socks for all groups are to be dress socks or crew type socks that pull up to mid-calf. They must cover the ankle & mid-calf or higher. Black Knee-Hi’s acceptable for Concert Season.**

- **Drillmaster Shoes (for marching band)-Students purchase. Information provided in band camp letter.**
- **Clean Drillmaster Shoes may be worn during concert if desired.**
- **Concert Band, Wind Ensemble & Color Guard participants make up the Marching Band.**
