- 1) Welcome/Introduction
  - a) 14 people present
- 2) Review of Minutes- Shawna Stevens

- 3) Treasurer's Report-Amanda McNicholas
  - a) Eight teachers have used funds-Palow and Sadler have not. A few more donations have trickled in since last time, but the donations drive has pretty much wrapped up. \$2400 left in budget. There will be some extra funds as we will not set up a DMEF website.

Sylvia is interested and we are trying to coordinate an in-person meeting here in Davis. Can we reimburse her for her travel costs? Marissa suggested going to the campus since it's very beautiful and well-organized. Cindy moved to use \$75 out of Professional Development to bring the director to Davis to discuss partnering with her training center. Tim Weaver seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.
