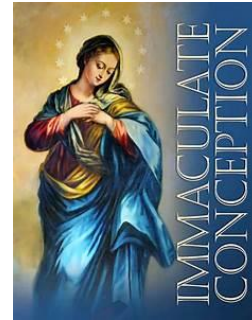

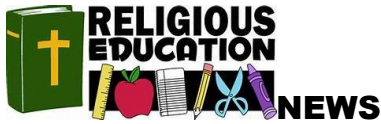

A reminder that the Diocese of Harrisburg requires a two year sacramental preparation for First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. Class time for grades kindergarten through high school is from 9:45 AM to 11:00 AM on Sunday mornings during the school year.

The preschool class meets on Sundays from 9:45 AM to 10:45 AM in the church basement (across from Mary's Kitchen). The children are taught Catholic prayers, traditions, and Bible stories—along with crafts and activities. (In a fun and nurturing setting!)

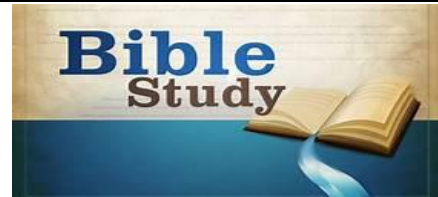
