#### **BUMC Fundraising Policies 1/2023**

The following policies apply to all people's/groups' fundraising actions at Belleview United Methodist Church.

Fundraising efforts must be preapproved by the BUMC Leadership Board. Please fill out a "Fundraising Form" (available by the mailboxes by the office) and return it to the office at least one month in advance of the fundraiser. "Facility Use" request forms (available by the mailboxes) must also be approved if the event is on campus.

Prior to approval, fundraisers must clearly state, on the "Fundraising Form", WHAT the fundraiser is for and WHERE the proceeds will go PRIOR to voting on it. At this time, monies raised should benefit BUMC. There are many activities, missions and programs that can benefit within the church which in turn benefits the community.

There will be NO approval for auctions, raffles, drawings or games of chance since they are not in line with policies of the Book of Resolutions. "It is expected that United Methodist churches abstain from the use of raffles, lotteries, bingo, door prizes, other drawing schemes, and games of chance for the purpose of gambling or fund-raising." The BUMC Leadership Board will meet the 2nd Thursday of each month at 6:30pm.


