How to improve meetings

Meeting too long:

Limit time to 2 hrs.; fewer speakers; limit q&a time and time for speakers; limit guest speaker to 15 minutes; do not have special guest speaker (not enough time); speed up pace of meeting;

Lost meeting with rambling board member reports; disseminate information by email about issues to be discussed prior to the meeting (i.e. security cameras); quarterly meetings with shorter agenda; an update to underground wiring should not be opened to discussion at the general meeting

Facility: better use of microphones; need better acoustical and visuals; better graphics (fewer lines) – not clear- or handouts or digital slides ahead of time; please repeat questions from the floor; lights on screen made slides hard to see; simpler slides; better use of microphones; all overhead fact sheets should be tested prior to meeting

Social: make coffee earlier

Positives: you're doing a great job; great already; thanks to all board and committee members
