Remember: Please bring new personal hygiene items (soap, toothpaste, etc.) to each meeting for collection and delivery to Diakonia in West Ocean City.



Medicare Doc Pay Saved – for Now

President Obama has signed legislation that blocks pay cuts for <u>Medicare</u> physicians for one year. The measure is aimed at stabilizing medical care for fearful seniors worried by the growing number of doctors who threatened to stop treating Medicare patients if scheduled fee reductions took effect Jan. 1. Before signing the law, the president called on Congress to come up with a "permanent solution that seniors and their doctors can depend on." (See more at www.aarp.org)

Go to http://drugsavings.aarp.org/ and put in your medications to find out if there are other medications that will have the same effect, but are cheaper. The site will list typical costs for both your medicine and the alternatives, and will sometimes ask you to make a selection on reasons for treatment.
