Minutes of September 7, 2021 Public Hearing

The Huntington Township Trustees met in special scheduled session at 6:45 PM at the Township Hall for the purpose of hearing from the public on a proposed Zoning Amendment. Meeting called to order with the pledge of Allegiance by Robert Holmes. Also present were Walter Rollin, Jed Lamb, Dennis Finkel, Lyn Ickes and Sheila Lanning. The floor was open to public comments on the proposed Zoning Amendment adding a Conservation District to the Township. Hearing no comments, the meeting adjourned on a motion by Lamb with a second by Rollin at 6:54 PM. Roll call: three yeas.

Minutes of September 7, 2021 Regular Scheduled Meeting

The Huntington Township Trustees met in regular scheduled session at 7:00 PM at the Township Hall. Meeting called to order with the pledge of Allegiance by Robert Holmes. Also present were Walter Rollin, Jed Lamb, Dennis Finkel, Matt Combs, Lyn Ickes and Sheila Lanning.

Motion by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve the minutes of the regular scheduled meeting on August 16, 2021 as written. Roll call: three yeas. Motion by Rollin with a second by Lamb to approve the August financial reports showing year to date revenue of \$431,118.09, year to date expenditures of \$343,136.04 and bank balances of \$395,551.02. Roll call: three yeas. Checks 9646-9672 and payments totaling \$22,337.97 approved for payment. Motion by Lamb with a second by Holmes to authorize Resolution 2021-45 an application for the American Rescue Plan Fiscal Recovery Funds of \$141,518.80. Roll call: three yeas. Trustees will hold a work session to discuss options for use of the recovery funds. Lanning filed the application and presented choices for the funds: electrification of Park pavilion, upgrade to heating and/or cooling systems in Township buildings to increase proper air flow, broadband outreach to residents without access by working with Lorain Medina Rural Electric or Armstrong, water infrastructure for residents by working with Rural Lorain County Water Authority, sewer assistance for residents in need. The Township will receive half the funds in 2021 and the remainder in 2022. Motion by Lamb with a second by Rollin to authorize Resolution 2021-46 an application for the ODOT Township grant program. Roll call: three yeas. Trustees met with Steve from ODOT, they would like our Township to get the grant. The Trustees intend to use the grant for chip and seal of Township roads. Some Townships are not applying for the grant per word of mouth.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

WATER BOARD- Lamb: meeting tomorrow, will be attending a Milwaukee Conference.

LORCO- Lamb: meeting Thursday, will check to see if they are applying for American Rescue Plan funds.

AMBULANCE- Holmes: meeting Friday and Tuesday.

SHERIFF- 53 calls in August.

FIRE- Rollin: Meeting last Wednesday, open house is delayed until Spring 2022. Working on odds and ends in the new building.

SWAC- Finkel: Grant and mini grant culverts are done.

ZONING BUSINESS/NEWS- Public Hearing Thursday 9/9 for Rollin variance. *Motion* by Holmes with a second by Lamb to authorize *Resolution 2021-47* amending the Zoning Resolution by adding Conservation District. Roll call: three yeas.

THRIVE & OFFICE ON AGING- Rollin: still working on what to do with grant money received, did put in a pickle ball court in Wellington.

CEMETERY- Lanning: sold one single lot and interred one full burial. Owens family member looking into buying a lot.

ROADS and EQUIPMENT: Finkel: ripped out some trees and cutting back some bank. Inquiry on culverts for Denise Emery on Baker Road, old Gradall needs some wiring work. Roller had some electrical issues and put in new gauges.

RECYCLING- Lanning: sent request for grant reimbursement of \$1,968.07. *Motion* by Holmes with a second by Lamb to set fall dumpster days as Friday 10/15/21 and Saturday 10/16/21 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Roll call: three yeas.

TRASH CONSORTIUM- nothing

EMPLOYEES- Combs: very busy days, summer helper Jared Bradford is done working.

PREVIOUS BUSINESS:

RAILROAD MEETING- Rollin and Holmes met with railroad representative 8/24/21 to discuss installation of crossing gates on Stewart Road West of SR 58. Land owner Russell Rollin will have to work on moving his farm access driveway if the gates are installed. Discussed possible guardrails, emails sent regarding moving the driveway. Railroad willing to work with property owner. Holmes had paperwork to have the County paint railroad crossing on the roadway initially with the Township doing maintenance thereafter. **Consensus** to not file the paper work for the County to paint the railroad crossing on the roadway. Lyn Ickes: how does Stewart Road get crossbucks and not SR 58 crossing. Received email from Randy Johr on railway crossings and personal property.
