ORDINANCE NO. 20-04

A CITY OF NEWTON ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 38-1-7 MULTIPLE UNIT RATE OF THE NEWTON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Newton, Jasper County,

Illinois that SECTION 38-1-7 be amended in its entirety to provide as follows:

38-1-7 <u>MULTIPLE UNIT RATE.</u>

- (A) Whenever **two** (2) or more residential dwelling units and/or commercial units are served by a single water meter, the bills shall be computed as if each unit were metered separately under the rate schedules listed in this Chapter. The minimum charge shall be computed in a like manner.
- (B) Effective March 15, 2020, whenever **two (2)** or more residential dwelling units and/or commercial units are served by a single water meter, the following rates shall apply:

WATER - FLAT RATE \$9.00 per 1000 gallon Minimum \$9.00

WASTEWATER – FLAT RATE \$12.00 per 1000 gallon of metered water Minimum \$12.00

- (C) For **two (2)** or more residential dwelling units and/or commercial units served by single water meter as of **March 15, 2020**, Subparagraph B shall not apply until such time as said residential dwelling units or commercial units are the subject of a transfer of ownership; and following said transfer of ownership, the rate schedule in Subparagraph B above shall apply.
- (D) Commencing with the first billing cycle for each customer after May 1, 2021 and on May 1 every year thereafter, there shall be an automatic increase of Five (5%) percent to the billing rate tables unless, upon review by the City Council, the City Council shall determine not to apply the Five (5%) percent increase.

Except as amended hereby, CHAPTER 38 UTILITIES shall remain in full force and effect according to its original terms.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
