GRAND & CONSOLATION FINALS RULES

- 1.) Region 1 Grand Finals will be held at Glacier Lanes in Everett. Region 1 Consolation Finals will be held at Evergreen Lanes in Evergreen. Region 2 Finals to be held at Paradise Lanes in Tacoma. Region 2 Consolation Finals will be held at Prairie Lanes in Yelm. The SUPER Finals will be held at West Seattle Bowl in Seattle at Noon on Saturday August 25th, 2018.
- 2.) There is no cost to the teams in either the Grand or Consolation Finals! All fees have been paid through their league dues. One out of every two teams cash in the Grand or Consolation Finals. Of the \$8 per week, contributed during the season, \$5.75 gets allocated to the Grand Finals and \$2.75 gets allocated to the Consolation Finals.
- 3.) Finals Tournaments will use a team handicap of 90% of 800 with a 100% reverse handicap for teams with an average over 800. Individuals will use their highest Spring Classic average on the 12th week of that league with a minimum of 18 or more games. If the average is 10 pins below their 2017/2018 book average, then they must use the book average less 5 pins. If an incorrect average is reported, USBC Rule #319A-1,2,3 applies.
- 4.) Teams are limited to 2 substitutions in the Finals. Subs must have bowled a Spring Classic League and have bowled 18 or more games. Regular team members with 6 or less games must have a book average of 21 or more games in 2017/2018. No blind scores shall be allowed as per USBC Rule #322.
- 5.) If a bowler is bowling in multiple Spring Classic Leagues, the average they are carrying on each team will be used for each team during the tournament (subject to Classic Tournament Average guidelines).
- 6.) A bowler may enter the Grand and/or Consolation Finals as many times as he/she is a member of a different team and may sub as per Rule #6. Not more than 2 players on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings - Rule #315.
- 7.) Tournaments will be USBC sanctioned. Entries close August 1st, 2018.
- 8.) USBC Rule #319D. Tournament prize winnings, does not apply.
- 9.) All participants are to be familiar with average adjustment requirements of USBC Rule #319E.
- 10.) Prize pay-outs will be announced prior to the start of the Finals.
- 11.) Directors retain the right to re-rate any bowler and assign averages in the Finals. Re-rating must be accomplished before the entrant bowls.
- 12.) Bowling centers must submit a final average standing sheet for all Spring Classic Leagues to both centers hosting the Grand and Consolation Finals.
- 13.) Prize money will be returned to participants within 30 days from the conclusion of the finals. Checks are made out to the team captain.
- 14.) If a league has an uneven team number - Example: 7 teams then 3 would go to the Grand Finals and 4 would go to the Consolation Finals.
- 15.) Rules not specifically covered above shall be governed by USBC Rules.
