

Barnes Compost Program

Berlin Heights Village Monthly Collection

Residential Yard Waste Only

When: First weekend of each month during Barnes normal business hours
(facility is closed in January and February)

Where: 1630 Camp Road, Huron

How does the program work?

Village residents will check in at the entrance booth. You must have a driver's license showing a valid Village address. You should tell the attendant that you are dropping off material as part of the Berlin Heights drop off program. There is no charge to the resident.

What type of materials are accepted for compost?

- Brush
- Tree Trimmings (13" diameter or less)
- Grass and Yard Trimmings
- Leaves and Flower Trimmings
- Garden Plants and Garden Trimmings
- Wood Chips
- Sod and Soil
- Christmas Trees

How are the materials to be packaged?

Paper yard waste bags are accepted. If plastic bags are used, individuals delivering the material must empty the bags on site and remove the bags or dispose of the bags in the provided receptacles. Barnes cannot accept yard waste in plastic bags. **ALL PLASTIC MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE MATERIAL AS IT IS DUMPED ON SITE.**

What type of materials are NOT accepted for compost?

- Plastic or trash
- Animal manures
- Food waste
- Brush or tree limbs over 13" in diameter
- Stumps
- Painted or Treated wood of any kind
- Construction and Demolition material
- Rocks or Clay
