

The key to the issue is in the centurion's words that we financial shape. pray a version of at every Mass. According to the story, the centurion has a dying slave most dear to him, and those around Jesus urge him to assist this Roman because, as they say, "He deserves to have you do this for him, for he loves our nation and he built a synagogue for us." In other words, here is a man surely worthy of a miracle. Yet the humble centurion sends word to Jesus from a distance: "Lord, do not trouble yourself, for I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof. Therefore I did not consider myself worthy to come to you; but say the word and let my servant be healed."

It is for this, then, that we pray at each Mass: not to be made worthy, because that is beyond us, but simply to be healed; or as we used to say, that our souls would be healed.




