

**Prov 3:1** My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

**Deut 8:1** All the commandments which I command thee this day shall ye observe to do, that ye may live, and multiply, and go in and possess the land which the LORD sware unto your fathers.

**Deut 30:16** In that I command thee this day to love the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commandments and his statutes and his judgments, that thou mayest live and multiply: and the LORD thy God shall bless thee in the land whither thou goest to possess it.

**Prov 3:2** For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.

**Ps 119:165** Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

**Prov 3:3** Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:

**Deut 6:8** And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.

**Exod 13:9** And it shall be for a sign unto thee upon thine hand, and for a memorial between thine eyes, that the LORD'S law may be in thy mouth: for with a strong hand hath the LORD brought thee out of Egypt.

**Exod 13:16** And it shall be for a token upon thine hand, and for frontlets between thine eyes: for by strength of hand the LORD brought us forth out of Egypt.

**Prov 3:4** So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.

**Prov 3:5** Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

**Prov 3:6** In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

**1Chr 28:9** And thou my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searcheth all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee; but if thou forsake him, he will cast thee off for ever.

**Rev 2:23** and all the churches shall know that **I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.**

**Prov 3:7** Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

**Rom 12:16** Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

**Rom 12:18** If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

**2Cor 13:11** Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

**1Pet 3:8** Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous:

**Prov 3:8** It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.

**Prov 3:9** Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:

**Prov 3:10** So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

**Prov 3:11** My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:

**Prov 3:12** For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son in whom he delighteth.

**Prov 3:13** Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.

**Prov 3:14** For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.

**Job 28:13** Man knoweth not the price thereof; neither is it found in the land of the living.

**Prov 3:15** She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.

**Prov 3:16** Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.

**Prov 3:17** Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.

**Matt 11:29** Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

**John 13:15** For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

**Prov 3:18** She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her.

**Prov 11:30** The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that winneth souls is wise.

**Gen 2:9** And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

**Rev 2:7** He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.

**Prov 3:19** The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens.

**Ps 104:24** O LORD, how manifold are thy works! In wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches.

**Ps 40:5** Many, O LORD my God, are thy wonderful works which thou hast done, and thy thoughts which are to us-ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: if I would declare and speak of them, they are more than can be numbered.

**Ps 65:9** Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water: thou preparest them corn, when thou hast so provided for it.

**Prov 3:20** By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.

**Gen 7:11** In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

**Prov 3:21** My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:

**Prov 3:22** So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.

**Prov 3:23** Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.

**Prov 3:24** When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.

**Job 11:19** Also thou shalt lie down, and none shall make thee afraid; yea, many shall make suit unto thee.

**Prov 3:25** Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh.

**Prov 3:26** For the LORD shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken.

**Prov 3:27** Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it.

**Rom 13:7** Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour.

**Luke 20:25** And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

**Mark 12:7** But those husbandmen said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours.

**Prov 3:28** Say not unto thy neighbour, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee.

**Lev 19:13** Thou shalt not defraud thy neighbour, neither rob him: the wages of him that is hired shall not abide with thee all night until the morning.

**Prov 3:29** Devise not evil against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.

**Prov 3:30** Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done thee no harm.

**Prov 3:31** Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.

**Ps 37:1** Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

**Prov 23:17** Let not thine heart envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of the LORD all the day long.

**Prov 24:19** Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked;

**Prov 3:32** For the froward is abomination to the LORD: but his secret is with the righteous.

**Prov 3:33** The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just.

**Deut 11:28** And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

**Deut. 28:15** But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

**Prov 3:34** Surely he scorneth the scorers: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

**Jas 4:6** But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

**Matt 23:12** **And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.**

**1Pet 5:5** Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

**Prov 3:35** The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools.
