Electricity Support Bill Assistance

(Supported by Ontario Energy Board)

Through this program you can get a monthly credit that will reduce your monthly electricity bill

The amount of credit depends on two factors:

- How many people live in the home
- Your combined household income

Low-Income Energy Assistance Program

(LEAP- Bill Assistance)

This program provides a one-time grant towards your electricity or natural gas bill if you are temporarily unable to make ends meet in an emergency situation. Low-income customers can get up to \$500 in emergency assistance for your electricity bills (\$600 if your home is heated electrically and \$500 for gas bills).

The assistance is only available if you are behind on your bill – or in arrears – and may have a service disruption. It is for emergency situations only and is not meant to provide you with ongoing help to pay your monthly bill.

****You cannot receive more money than what you owe on your bill****

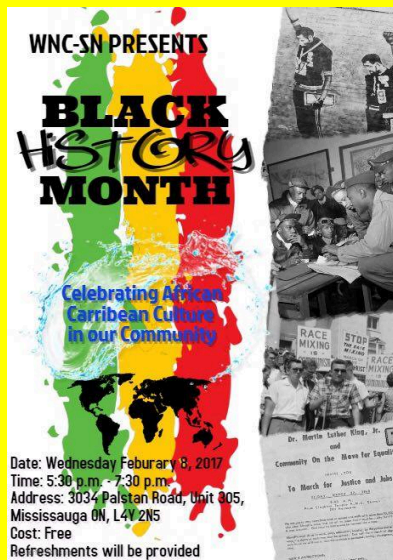
Various topics are discussed that are of interest to youths and women to help meet their needs.

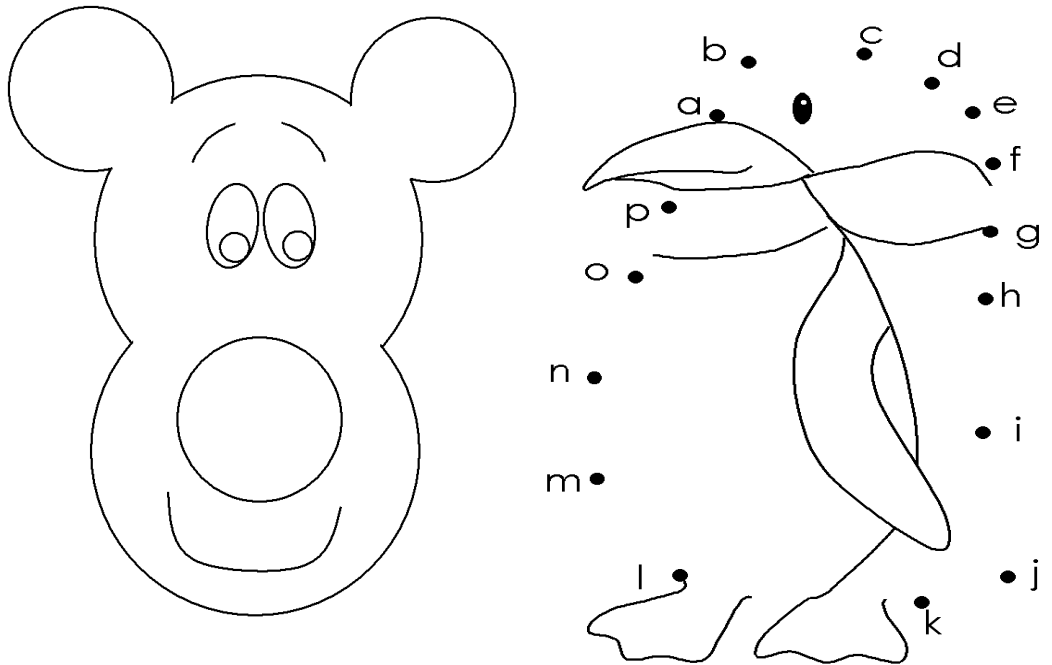
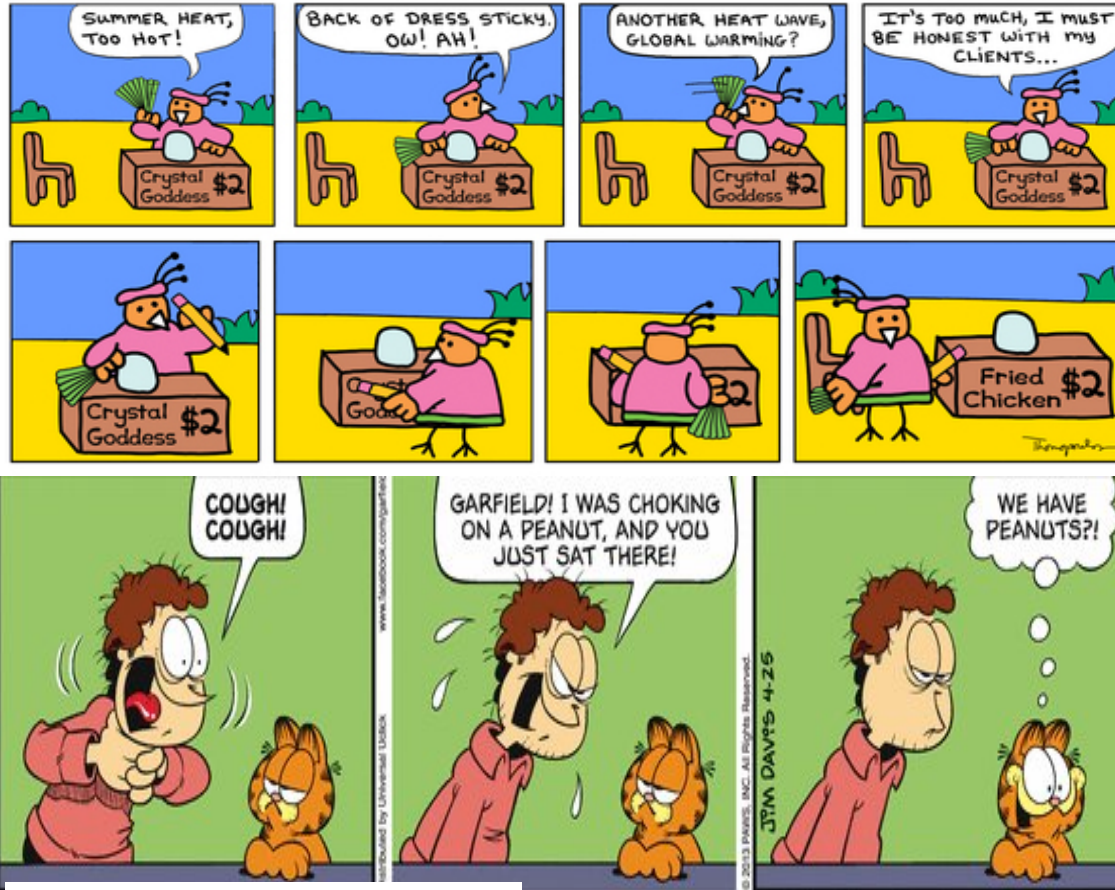
