THE BIG 12 WILL NOT EXPAND RIGHT NOW

The Big 12 Conference could not reach the requisite consensus on any of the expansion candidates it considered and will stand pat at 10 members for the time being. From an initial pool of 19 candidates that initiated interest, the Big 12 interviewed Air Force, BYU, UCF, Cincinnati, Colorado State, UConn, Houston, Rice, South Florida, SMU and Tulane last month in Dallas. On July 20th, the Big 12 voted unanimously to explore expansion. Commissioner Bob Bowlsby said at that time, that the Big 12 would be looking "for members that will grow over time as we grow. We want schools that bring stability, that have a high top end." But on October 17th, after the Big 12 presidents and chancellors deliberated for more than five hours at the Grand Hyatt in Phoenix, Arizona, no expansion candidate generated a supermajority, or the eight votes, necessary to garner an invitation. The process never resulted in a formal vote being taken on any individual expansion candidate. The Big 12 had hired two consulting firms to explore how expansion could impact the league, particularly in the long-term. For a league that has lost four members since 2010 (three of which, Nebraska, Texas A&M and Colorado have football teams currently ranked in the AP Top 25) appears vulnerable to further pillaging when its grant of rights agreement expires in 2025. I'm hoping that the Big 12 stays together because I believe it's a great league. Personally, I believe that this is not a dead issue and that within 2 years, the Big 12 will once again revisit the possibility of expansion. Here at THE BLITZ we felt that Houston and Cincinnati were the 2 best candidates and that BYU and UCF were close behind. Stay tuned.

FOOTBALL TIDBITS

Penn State rallied to pin Ohio State with their first true road loss under Urban Meyer, ending their 20-game winning streak which is tied for the 3rd longest in major college history. We have that list below. Penn State also got their first win over a top-2 ranked opponent when the Nittany Lions themselves were unranked since beating Woody Hayes and Ohio State in 1964.

QB Patrick Mahomes of Texas Tech broke the FBS record for total offense in 1 game, with 819 yards in the Red Raiders' 66-59 loss vs Oklahoma. The previous record had been held by Connor Halliday of Washington State with 751 in 2014.

#21 Auburn's 53-point win (56-3) over #17 Arkansas, produced the largest margin of defeat by an AP-ranked team this season. In that game Auburn's 543 yards rushing were the most ever in an SEC regular-season game since the league began in 1933. It's the seventh-most in SEC history, including non-conference opponents.

Alabama has held their opponents to 14 points or fewer in 83 games in 9+ seasons under Nick Saban.

Colorado held Stanford to 5 points, that's fewest scored by a Stanford squad since they scored just 3 vs Arizona State in 2007.

After scoring 44 points in the first half vs NC State, Louisville has scored at least 35 points in the 1st half 5 times this season, which is the most in the FBS this season.

When Oregon lost in double overtime to California, it marked the third consecutive game that the Ducks have allowed at least 600 yards of total offense by the opposition.

NEBRASKA AT WISCONSIN



When the Big Ten added Nebraska back in 2011, this is what they envisioned. They wanted another school that would fit in academically, but they also wanted an athletic department that was strong in all sports especially in football. The Huskers football program seems to be headed in the right direction under Mike Riley as they visit another Big Ten power, Wisconsin. It will be televised on ESPN at 7:00 PM Eastern.

Nebraska will go as far as Tommy Armstrong can take them. He is a true dual threat QB. When he is on, there are few in the country better. If they can get the running game going, this Nebraska offense can be lethal. The "Black Shirt" Cornhusker defense is getting better but they're still not where they eventually want to be.

Wisconsin Freshman QB Alex Hornibrook, doesn't have the strongest arm but he has great touch. He also has RB Corey Clement to take some of the pressure off. When the Badgers can run effectively, they can be dominant.

Wisconsin leads the all-time series 6-4. The Badgers are 3-1 vs the Huskers in Madison and since Nebraska joined the Big Ten, Wisconsin has won 4 of the 5 games. This looks like a great game on paper. Both have explosive offenses and both defenses are solid as well. We're going to go with the home team Badgers to come away with a hard fought 30-27 win over the Huskers.



STADIUMS OF THE PAST SERIES: ARCHBOLD STADIUM

Prior to the construction of the Carrier Dome, Syracuse played all of their home games on that same plot of land at Archbold Stadium for 72 years from 1907-1978.

When it opened in 1907 Archbold Stadium was just the third concrete football stadium in the United States. The stadium was oval in shape and included a unique giant 40 foot concrete gateway arch located at the west endzone main entrance. There were two turrets on either side of the arch reminiscent of what you would see at a castle.

The seating capacity at Archbold Stadium peaked in the 1950's at 40,000 but by the time Syracuse played their final game there, capacity was down to 26,388 due to stricter fire codes. In the mid 1970's it was obvious that Syracuse was either going to have to fund a major renovation and expansion of Archbold Stadium or build a new stadium. With the basketball arena (Manley Field House) holding just 9,500 it was decided to build a domed stadium on the site of Archbold Stadium which would be the new home for both the football team and the men's basketball team.

In 1979, Syracuse was forced to play their "home" games at Rich Stadium in Orchard Park, NY, Giants Stadium in East Rutherford, NJ and Schoelkopf Field in Ithaca, NY after Arcbold Stadium was demolished and while the Carrier Dome was being constructed. Syracuse was 265-112-20 .693 all-time at Archbold Stadium.
