#### **GENERAL MEETING – NOVEMBER 8th**

Steven de Sousa, National Fleet Service Manager with Mack Trucks Canada, made quite an impressive presentation on the inroads that Natural Gas has made in our trucking industry. (The original presentation on training had to be substituted due to staff logistics).



There is a consensus that given the results in the recent US elections, the already fast paced NG program will see further adoption accelerated. The US has an abundance of Natural Gas which will greatly assist in their efforts towards self sufficiency and a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions. Natural Gas is much friendlier than Propane, is excellent for the internal combustion engine; is clean &

efficient. The comparative costs and operational logistics of pure diesel vs with Natural Gas is another story. Natural Gas is extracted by a process called hydraulic fracturing, or 'fracking', whereby water and other chemicals create fractures in rock formations, forcing them further open, allowing more oil and gas to flow. Some companies, particularly in waste management, have received, and have on order, Natural Gas trucks exclusively for their fleets. And this in spite of the woefully inadequate means of fuel supply and servicing capability available today. So, as Steve very persuasively pointed out, we need to get ready!
