From the President's Desk:

Notice to ALL Members: As of July 1, 2016 per PA Act 153 it is now required & mandatory by Pennsylvania State law that all volunteers that have direct contact with unaccompanied minors have the State Police Criminal Record Check, PA Child Abuse History Record Check, & FBI Criminal History report (if they have not been a PA resident for the last 10 years) and our Volunteer Clearance Procedure & Application and file them with the club. The policy is located on our website. In plain English: If you have not submitted the necessary paperwork you may not be involved in any activities with unaccompanied minors (people under 18). You must leave the activity, or the minor must leave the activity. There is no wiggle room in this matter and we have been pushing anyone in those type of positions to get the necessary clearances for 2 years now. It is simple and free. Any club member found to be in violation of this law will have their membership revoked as specified in Article VII of the club's by-laws.

Please remember that a spousal membership at our club is not a family membership. Members may accompany guests on our grounds. Family members, especially children, who do not have current membership cards with their name on them are not members, they may be your guests. Guests must be with you, under your immediate supervision, and following all rules as outlined in the by-laws, ground rules, or posted.




