STEWARDSHIP Gratitude in Action: Our Way of Life

We, as Stewards, are created in the image and likeness of God. We should look at the person next to us and "see the face of God". Yes, it can sometimes be a challenge, but then, we stop and realize God loves us also, despite our less than perfect qualities.

Stewards trust God, knowing He is always "there" when we need Him. Can God say the same about us? Do we hear His call and respond with a resounding "yes" to His invitation to serve Him or our neighbor? Or, do we rather ignore His voice, maybe even say "no"?

Are we true and authentic in our prayer, our behavior, our words? Do we say what we mean, mean what we say, and not just speak empty words? Do we act in situations the way God would act, or do we respond in a manner that satisfies us, regardless of how it may impact another? Does our prayer reflect meaningful, honest and humble dialogue with God?

We know God judges, not by physical appearance, but rather by actions and attitudes of the heart. Does my attractive exterior match my invisible interior, or is there a dark contrast? Those who lead should reflect honesty when presenting themselves to others, however, ALL of us are called to truth of character and authenticity of self.

Saint Paul tells us to do nothing out of selfishness, to humbly regard others as more important than ourselves. If we follow this advice, we can look at the person next to us and see reflected the face of God. Our prayer will be sincere; our words spoken with clarity and meaning. Our "yes" will mean "yes". Our heart will be open to God's judgment, not fearing He will see some hypocrisy undetected by others.
