VFW National has raised the annual dues effective 7/1/24, We highly recommend converting to a Lifetime Member so you will not have to pay anything else in the future for membership. Convert your membership by 10/31 to receive the \$50 incentive from the Auxiliary. To remain in good standing, all dues MUST be received by 12/22/24.
