ASSISTANT CHIEF CAMPBELL'S REPORT

A/C Campbell and Firefighter Adam Meyer went to Pierce on January 3, 2019 to inspect the repairs on the truck. After a thorough review, there are a few outstanding items that Pierce will be addressing in the next few weeks.

Ambulance 91 (Freightliner) front and rear brakes have been replaced.

Ambulance 94 (International) went to Chandler Services for service on a head gasket that had failed. The ambulance was out of service for approximately one week and is now back in service.

We have received the final Stryker Power Load that will be installed on Ambulance 94. Once this is installed, all four ambulances will be equipped with this system.

Congratulations to Engineer Boomsma on receiving his Fire Office 1 certificate.

The January training calendar was reviewed by the Board.

The Board reviewed the POC ride-along report for the month of December.

ASSISTANT CHIEF CIRELLI'S REPORT

Denise Pavlik, the new executive director of Laraway Communications Center, was in attendance, and introduced herself to the Trustees. The Chiefs had met with Director Pavlik on January 7 to discuss the future of Laraway Communications Center and their expected outcomes.

We have experienced intermittent issues with the VHF radio system for the past year, creating outages and resulting in the need for alternative dispatching procedures. Will County has commissioned a county-wide 800 mhz radio system that is owned, managed and maintained by Will County EMA. This system includes many built-in redundancies and provides our service area with good coverage. Will County EMA has reserved space on the radio system for the Lincoln-Way group to utilize and has patched the radio systems together, allowing talk/receive to occur on both systems. This has allowed the use of the Will County radio system to be used for paging, which alters the fire stations and crews. To leverage the capability of the new radio systems, we have purchased 10 dual-band pagers, allowing alerting on either VHF or 800 mhz. This will replace about half of our pagers, allowing the crews to be paged out through the 800 mhz system. In the unlikely event of a failure with the 800 system, crews can turn to the VHF system for alerting. Half of the pagers will be purchased this fiscal year; the remaining in the next fiscal year.

There was no Homer Glen Public Services and Safety committee meeting in January due to the New Year holiday.

We currently have two employees out on reported duty-related injuries.

The Trustees reviewed the December code enforcement reports and public education surveys.

CHIEF'S REPORT

The FY2018 ambulance billing data was reviewed.

The Mokena Miracles assisted three local families with various necessary items for Christmas.

This year the District collected Christmas toys for donations to local organizations. The Frankfort Township Food Pantry, My Joyful Heart, Journey Pregnancy and Life Hub, Lincoln-Way Special Recreation Association and Mokena Elementary Schools each received a van full of toys. A special thank you to Kathy Ferraro for organizing this very successful toy drive.

The Trustees have no objection to a Standing Operating Guideline which addresses upcoming retirements and a retirement plaque to indicate those who have served at least 20 years of full-time service with MFPD and then have retired.

As recommended by the Board of Trustees, the Fire Commissioners have been trained on the current Sexual Harassment Policy at their last meeting.

The Fire Commissioners met on January 7, 2019 to temporarily appoint Tim Boomsma to the rank of Lieutenant; not to exceed 180 days. This temporary appointment will be effective on January 14, 2019 and is needed due to a Lieutenant off on Worker's Compensation.
