The Selectmen will write a letter to the realtor immediately to remedy the situation. The Selectmen instructed Harold to go up and take pictures tomorrow.

Deb Leahy wanted to follow-up on her earlier question on why Avitar has been to her house once a year since 2015. She has no new construction. Tracy will call Avitar in the morning. She also discussed another resident's property that is not being properly assessed on Stage Road. She also wanted to follow-up on the status of the L-Chip material that was requested by the Library. Bill discussed the new draft Camper Permit which contains the new language as voted at Town Meeting. Camper permits will be issued by the Selectmen.

The Board reviewed an Intent to Cut for Peter Druz. It was determined that he will need a road bond for the Class VI Road.

John made a motion to approve the Power of Attorney in order for Sager & Smith to auction the town-owned properties on June 3, 2017. To be signed and notarized tomorrow. Second by Bill.

John made a motion to sign two pistol permits. Second by Bill. All in favor.

At 7:45 Bill made a motion to adjourn. Second by John. All in favor.
