Lloyd A. Milliken, 83, former owner of Milliken Funeral Home in Sebawaing, died Tuesday, April 5, in St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Clinton Township, following a heart attack.

The Milliken family purchased the Sebawaing funeral home from Mr. and Mrs. H. J. Bauer and moved to Utica at the start of 1953 when they sold the home to Mr. and Mrs. Charles F. Witae. Mr. Milliken operated the Utica Funeral Home from 1953-1969.

He was a resident of Macomb Township, and was a member of St. Lawrence Catholic Church and Knights of Columbus. He was a past president of Utica Rotary Club.
