BE SAFE, BE ALERT

Several break-ins have been reported in neighboring communities over the past few weeks. Fortunately, no break-ins have been reported in Andover Glen, but it does serve as a reminder for all of us that crime is always looking for an opportunity.

With the warmer weather we all want to be outdoors more, and unfortunately so do the criminals. Here are a few tips to keep you and your property safe this spring.

- Make sure that your garage door is closed.
- Keep your doors and windows locked. Use door & window stops to prohibit access
- Light the exterior of your property. It costs just a few cents per month to keep your porch light on. Use timers when out of town.
- If your automobile is parked outside, keep it locked and valuables out of sight.
- Keep bikes, lawnmowers, garden tools, etc. out of sight.
- Pay attention to suspicious activity in the neighborhood. Write down descriptions of suspicious people and license plate numbers. Report this information to the APD (303-627-3100). You can also provide this information to Derrick Laughlin (303-489-2982), our Neighborhood Watch captain to distribute to our community via the email alert system.
- If you are away, arrange to have your mail and newspaper picked up daily, remove any flyers from your front door and remove trash containers from the street on pick-up days.
- Be wary of letting unfamiliar people into your home. Ask for identification, a phone number, references and a business card, and call the business to verify while the person remains outside the home. If there is any doubt, contact the police.
