#### **Emergency Food Pantry**

Never leave your cupboards bare. Keep a variety of nutritious foods on hand for quick, easy, economical meals when weather, natural disaster or illness keeps you home. Purchase several foods from each group. Use or replace items every 6 months.

#### Meat and Meat substitutes

Tuna fish, canned chicken, beef stew, macaroni & Cheese, spaghetti and meatballs, baked beans, hearty or chunky soups, condensed soups (split pea or minestrone), peanut butter.

#### Cereals, Breads, Pasta

Hot cereal, cold cereal, rice, noodles, spaghetti, corn muffin mix, whole wheat crackers, sesame bread sticks, oatmeal cookies.

#### **Fruits and Vegetables**

Canned vegetables (green beans, spinach, corn, peas, beets, carrots, mixed vegetables); Canned fruit (apricots, peaches, pears, applesauce, plums, raisins, grapefruit); fruit, tomato and vegetable juice, bean salad, beets.

#### Milk and Milk Products

Non-Fat dried or evaporated milk. Pasteurized process cheese spread.
